Delegation from the European Parliament visits Washington for the second of its twice yearly meetings with members of the US Congress and Government. The delegation will be headed by the Parliament's President Georges Spenale.

September 23-25

Delegation from the European Parliament goes to Springfield, Illinois. The party will attend a reception given by Governor Daniel Walker and a banquet given for President Gerald R. Ford by the Illinois Press Association. Other activities in the area include visits to a large "factory farm" growing corn and soybeans and to Abraham Lincoln's home and tomb.
