### DANISH PRIME MINISTER TO SPEAK AT NATIONAL PRESS CLUB

Prime Minister Anker Joergensen of Denmark will pay an official visit to Washington, D.C., from February 21 to February 23.

President Carter has invited the Social Democrat and former trade unionist, who is serving for the second time as Denmark's premier, in his capacity as head of the Danish government and also as the current president of the European Community's Council of Ministers.

The prime minister will be accompanied to Washington by Foreign Minister K.B. Andersen, who now serves as president of the EC Foreign Affairs Council.

In a speech last month to the European Parliament shortly after his accession to the EC office, Andersen outlined some principal objectives for Denmark during its six-month presidency: development of EC relations with the Third World, cooperation with the United States, advanced cooperation among the nine Community nations, movement toward Community enlargement, action to combat excessive unemployment and progress toward a multilateral trade talks resolution.

Prime Minister Joergensen is to address a National Press Club luncheon on Thursday, February 23, at 12:30 p.m. It will be the only press conference given by the prime minister during his stay in Washington.
