MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr LANGES on behalf of the Group of the European People's Party

pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure with request for urgent debate

on the rejection by the Council of the first supplementary budget 1982

## The European Parliament,

- A whereas Parliament fully approved, at its July 1982 partsession, the Commission's preliminary draft supplementary budget
  1982 which provided for savings of 500 m ECU in the agricultural sector to be allocated mainly to combat unemployment
  (youth unemployment) and world hunger,
- B outraged that the Council has refused to submit this supplementary budget,
- 1. Calls on the President of Parliament to resume immediately the trialogue with the Presidents of the Council and the Commission on this matter, as provided for in the Joint Declaration of 30 July 1982,
- 2. Notes at this point that the savings in the 1982 budget were not passed on to the Member States; these own resources must be used immediately for common measures in the social, development and regional sector,
- 3. Calls on the Commission and the Council, therefore, to submit a new supplementary draft budget immediately, i.e. early enough to ensure that this expenditure can still be committed in 1982.
