on COMMUNITY INDUSTRIAL STRATEGY

The European Parliament,

- a) whereas the European Council in London on 26-27 November 1981 invited the Commission to submit proposals on the new Community policies in time for the next European Council,
- b) whereas the European Council in Brussels on 29-30 March 1982 requested the Council to strengthen industrial policies on the basis of the Commission's proposals,
- c) whereas, during the Council of Industry Ministers on 4 May 1982, the Commission presented a document on industrial strategy drawn up in collaboration with Ministry of Industry officials from the Member States which repeats well-known statements of principle but remains vague and general on the specific action to be taken and even on the main aspects of the problem,
- d) whereas on the same occasion the Council authorized the Commission to submit further concrete proposals in due course,
 1. Considers that a proper Community industrial strategy is urgently needed, based not only on liberalization of the internal market but also and above all on the organization of joint action as regards production, investment incentives, energy and research policy, the organization of labour, taxation and the capital market in order to create a Community industrial basis of the greatest possible homogeneity, as has repeatedly been called for by Parliament;
 2. Calls on the Commission to put forward concrete Community industrial strategy proposals along these lines as soon as possible so that Parliament can deliver an opinion on them, the Council consider them in good time and the next European Council reach a decision on them.
 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and the Commission.
