# £12.5M TO UNITED KINGDOM UNDER REGIONAL FUND

(Fourth allocation of grants, 1980)

Attached is a list of the projects in respect of which grants were approved in December in the fourth allocation under the Fund's 1980 budget. A grant towards the cost of a study is included in the list. The money will be paid to the United Kingdom Government in step with national expenditure on the projects concerned. This brings Regional Fund grants to the UK to £157m in 1980, and to £566m since the Fund began operations in 1975.

About two-thirds of ERDF grants are towards infrastructure projects. This finance is passed on in full to the local and other public authorities concerned, thus reducing the amount they have to borrow to finance the investment in question. A major project of this kind in this latest announcement is for improvement at Manchester Airport.

As far as industrial projects are concerned, the Community grants now announced represent a Fund contribution of up to half the cost of the assistance given to individual projects by the United Kingdom Government. European Regional Development Fund grants are not paid to the companies concerned in addition to the assistance they receive from the Government.
