# £34M TO UNITED KINGDOM UNDER REGIONAL FUND



(Second allocation of grants, 1981)

Attached is a list of the projects in respect of which grants of £34 030 000 have been approved in the second allocation under the Fund's 1981 budget. The money will be paid to the United Kingdom Government in step with national expenditure on the projects concerned. This brings Regional Fund grants to the United Kingdom to £681m since the Fund began operations in 1975.

The latest grants aid further stages of an urban railway system in Tyne and Wear (£3.4m) and a peripheral distributor road in Cardiff (£2.1m) as well as an important gas distribution network in Gwent and Mid-Glamorgan (fl.4m).

About two-thirds of ERDF grants are towards infrastructure projects. This finance is passed on in full to the local and other public authorities concerned, thus reducing the amount they have to borrow to finance the investment in question.

As far as industrial projects are concerned, the Community grants now announced represent a Fund contribution of up to half the cost of the assistance given to individual projects by the UK Government. The grants are not paid to the companies concerned in addition to assistance they receive from Government.
