MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr BUTTAFUOCO, Mr ROMUALDI, Mr ALMIRANTE and Mr PETRONIO

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on the renewal of the Italian-Tunisian fishing agreement

#### The European Parliament,

- A. having regard to the fishing agreements concluded between the European Community and Guinea Bissau, Senegal, Norway, Spain, Canada and other countries,
- B. whereas the Italian-Tunisian fishing agreement, which the Community is responsible for renewing, expired on 19 June 1979,
- C. whereas at the last Council meeting on fisheries Italy again raised the question of the agreement asking for it to be renewed,
- D. whereas the fisheries sector is one of the mainstays of the Sicilian economy,
- E. whereas, because of the failure to renew the agreement, the work of the Sicilian motor-trawler fleets is made more difficult as they are forced to operate in waters at ever greater distances away from their home ports,
- F. having regard to the Tunisian authorities' feeble commitment to cooperate with the Community to reach an agreement,
- G. concerned at the increase in violent episodes such as the seizure of Sicilian motor-trawlers in international waters,
- H. concerned at the fact that these episodes often result in bloodshed,
- I. concerned that this continual delay in renewing the agreement may be detrimental to the prestige of the European institutions,
- 1. Requests that :
  - (a) the fishing agreement which expired on 19 June 1979 be renewed as a matter of urgency,
  - (b) negotiations be opened meanwhile with the appropriate Tunisian authorities to protect the lives and property of Sicilian fishermen who, operate along the African coast but exclusively in international waters,
  - (c) the Italian navy provide protection in international waters,
  - (d) the crews being held prisoner in African ports be freed and their fishing vessels released;
- 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission and the Council
