MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr MOORHOUSE

for entry in the register  
pursuant to Rule 49 of the Rules of Procedure

on the release of Mrs Anna Walentynowicz - founder member  
of Solidarity

The European Parliament,

A - deeply concerned by reports that Mrs Anna Walentynowicz, former member of the National Coordinating Committee of Solidarity, interned by the Polish Authorities when martial law was declared on 13 December 1981, and later imprisoned, has now been placed in a mental institution by the Polish Authorities,

B - deeply concerned that her health has deteriorated to such an extent,

1. Calls upon the Polish Authorities to give information on the whereabouts of Mrs Anna Walentynowicz and the state of her health;
2. Calls upon the Polish Authorities to allow an expert independent medical team access to Mrs Anna Walentynowicz, under the auspices of the Red Cross;
3. Requests its Bureau to provide financial assistance for such a visit by the medical team if required;
4. Calls upon the Polish Authorities to release Mrs Anna Walentynowicz by Christmas 1982;
5. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Polish Authorities, the Conference of Foreign Ministers meeting in political cooperation, and to the Red Cross in Geneva.
