MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Lord O'HAGAN, on behalf of the European Democratic  
Group

with request for topical and urgent debate

pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on Poland

'The European Parliament,

- A. noting the first anniversary of the imposition of martial law by the military authorities in Poland,
- B. mindful of its resolution 1-436/82 (Deschamps report),
  - 1. Repeats in the most emphatic terms its condemnation of the imposition and continuance of martial law in Poland;
  - 2. Condemns in particular the banning by the military authorities of the Polish Trade Union 'Solidarity';
  - 3. Urges the Council and the Foreign Ministers meeting in political cooperation to bring all appropriate pressure to bear on the Polish and Soviet authorities in attempting to persuade them to rescind martial law and legalise the Trade Union genuinely representative of Polish workers, 'Solidarity';
  - 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, the Council and the Ministers meeting in political cooperation.'
