MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION
tabled by Mr CABORN and Mr GLINNE, on behalf of the Socialist
    Group
with request for topical and urgent debate
pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure
on American intervention in Central America
```

A. taking note of the Declaration of Cancun, signed on 17 July by the rresideats of Colombia, Mozico, Panama and Venezuela.
B. welcoming the positive aposal of the Niceraguan Government, which on 19 July accepted the framework for multilateral negotiations proposed by the Contadora Group and issued its own 6. point Peace Plaa.
C. alarmed by the recont deployment of large Uaited Statas military forces in the region, which can only exacerbate regional tensions and increase the risk of war,

1. Heafiirms its support for the diplomatic initiativea of the Contadora Group, as expreseed is the Stuttgart Communique of Juae and by the statoment of the Greek Foreiga dinister, in his capacity as President of the Council of Ministers, or 29 July;
2. Calls on the Governmats of the Member States to give their full and unqualified support to the Contadora initiatives:
3. Calls on the Government of the United States to immediately withdraw dta warships and troops from the region and to halt its military manoouvres which are likely to jeopardise the peace initiativos;

4 . Asks its reesidents to forward this resolution to the Council of mindsters, to the koreign Ministors meeting in rolitical Co-operation and to the Goverment of the United States ;
5. Further asks its President to forward this resolution to the United Nations requesting that a U.N. conference on the situation in Central Anerica be organised by the end of 1983, using the peace initiatives of the Contadora Group as the basis of discussion.
