Group of European Progressive Democrats

with request for topical and urgent debate

pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on the establishment of a fisheries committee

The European Parliament,

- A. Having regard to the experience gained in the turbulent first 8 months of the Common Fisheries Policy, to its troubled past and to its uncertain future;
- B. Whereas the European Parliament has a pressing obligation to divert more of its attention to existing and planned legislation in the fisheries sector;
- C. Whereas this task is impossible in the absence of a full standing Committee on Fisheries;
  - 1. Calls upon its Bureau to take the necessary steps to immediately establish a full standing Committee on Fisheries,
  - 2. Instructs its President to forward this Resolution to its Bureau, to the Council and to the Commission.
