Subject: Introduction of summertime

The European Parliament has always made it quite clear that it considers agreement within the Community on the introduction of summertime to be absolutely essential. It is incomprehensible that at their meeting of 12 June 1978, the Transport Ministers, who are responsible for this matter, were unable to agree on the introduction of a common summertime in 1979 and that the people of Europe will again have to cope with three different time zones.
