Subject: Health protection

Between 1966 and 1975 the consumption of medicines increased by 156% in France and by 135% in Italy. This trend is not confined to these two countries and is causing concern among the medical profession throughout the Community.

The over-prescribing of medicines places a burden on the national health services and excessive or unreasonable self-medication is a threat to public health.

- What measures does the Commission intend to take to halt excessive consumption and wastage of medicines?
- 2. Does the Commission not feel there is an urgent need to launch a preventive informational and educational public health campaign among consumers?
- 3. Since the Council has not adopted the directives of June 1976 on the advertizing of proprietary medicines, does the Commission intend to submit a new proposal for a directive? If so, how will it differ from the first proposal?
- 4. Is the Commission prepared to take account in any new directive of the requests which Parliament is currently drafting in an own-initiative report on self-midication?
