with request for topical and urgent debate

pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on fisheries inspectors

'The European Parliament,

- A - aware of the responsibility it has in determining the annual Community Budget;
 - B - recalling the fact that funds were made available in the 1983 budget for the immediate recruitment of 13 Community Fisheries Inspectors;
 - C - concerned that not one Fisheries Inspector is yet in post;
 - D - aware of the responsibility it has in monitoring Community expenditure;
 - E - aware of the responsibility it has to make certain that Community policies are effective and fair;
 - F - aware of the responsibility it has for maintaining democratic control in the European Community and control of expenditure administered by the Commission,
1. Demands a full statement as to the Commission's failure to appoint Fisheries Inspectors as agreed by the budgetary authority and reaffirmed by the Council of Ministers in its agreement on the Common Fisheries Policy.
 2. Requests a statement from the President of the Commission acknowledging the urgency of these appointments and his assurance that he will personally ensure the highest priority, in appointing these Inspectors, thus safeguarding the Common Fisheries Policy.'
