The European Parliament,

- having regard to the need for the Nine to achieve harmonious economic growth, unperturbed by international monetary fluctuations and leading to the rapid elimination of unemployment,
- 1. Invites the Community to draw the consequences from the fact that the European Monetary System was promptly weakened by the first monetary disturbances which followed its introduction;
- Wishes that the Community draw up practical proposals to ensure effective control of the Eurodollar market, whose chaotic evolution constitutes a threat to our economies;
- 3. Asks the Community to coordinate the action taken by Member States in an effort to halt the sharp rise in interest rates which is hampering economic growth in Europe;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and Commission.
