

DECISIONS ON THE AGRICULTURAL PRICES 1989/90

Originating Department DG VI-01

Introduction

On 22 April, after a meeting lasting five days, the Council of Ministers reached unanimous agreement on the agricultural prices for 1989/90. Not since 1984 have the price negotiations ended so early in the year.

The Council decision does not deviate, on fundamentals, from the Commission proposals and reaffirms the policy adopted in recent years. It includes a freeze on prices in ecus, except for sugar, citrus fruit and durum wheat, for which the prices have been cut. It also provides for the reinforcement of measures to assist small producers and farmers in less favoured areas, especially those producing durum wheat (by increasing the aid in the traditional producing regions and extending it to new regions in the case of Spain and Greece), clive oil (by altering the definition of a small producer) and milk (by eliminating the co-responsibility levy for less-favoured areas and adjusting it, in other areas, in relation to the quantity produced).

The Council also decided to shorten by one month the period in which market intervention measures apply to cereals, rice and oilseeds and to continue to dismantle the monetary compensatory amounts. The stabilizers scheme was extended to include apples and cauliflowers.

The reductions in the co-responsibility levies in the milk sector will be offset by a reduction (of 2%) in the intervention price for butter and by other market management measures.

The price rises in national currency determined by the dismantling of the negative MCAs will continue, on the whole, to be lower than the rate of inflation in the countries concerned.

For speed of consultation the Council results are presented this year in the form of a summary table containing the Commission's original proposals, Parliament's position and the Council decisions.

The price proposals for 1989/90 and the related measures presented by the Commission to the Council were published in a special issue of Green Europe at the beginning of 1989.

Commission and Council undertakings given during the meeting held in April 1989 at which the agricultural prices were fixed for 1989/90

A. Agricultural markets

1. Stabilizers

The Commission will study the effect of the stabilizer mechanisms on the distribution of crop areas and/or the balance between field crops and will present a report on the subject after the 1990 and 1991 sowing periods.

2. Cereals and rice

While the stabilizer arrangements apply the Commission intends to set a maximum moisture content of 15% for all cereals (except durum wheat and rice) and a minimum specific weight of 62 kg/h for barley in Spain.

The Commission intends to prolong, while the stabilizer arrangements apply, the derogations provided for in Article 1(5) of Regulation (EEC) No 1569/77.1

The Commission is considering the administrative difficulties rising from the application of the co-responsibility levy and will present a report accompanied, where necessary, by appropriate proposals.

The Council undertakes to adopt a regulation for 1989/90 reducing by 3% the minimum price for potatoes for industrial use. The premium for the manufacture of starch has been fixed for 1989/90 at the same level as for the three preceding marketing years (ECU 18.70/t starch).

3. Oilseeds

The Commission will continue to allow Member States to use national methods of analysis during 1989/90.

¹ These derogations allow the following to be increased in the event of unfavourable weather conditions:

⁻ the maximum percentage of matter which is not basic cereal of unimpaired quality (to 15%);

the maximum percentage of germinated grains (to 12%);

the maximum percentage of shrivelled grains of common wheat and barley (to 15%);

⁻ the maximum percentage of "mitadiné" grains in durum wheat (to 60%).

4. Protein crops and fodder

The Commission intends to revise as soon as possible and in so far as it has the necessary technical data, the basket of products used to determine the market price of dried fodder.

The Commission intends to seek as quickly as possible a fair solution to the problems created by the introduction of the procedure for identifying peas and field beans for 1986 and 1987.

5. Sugar

The Commission undertakes to ensure, through the exercise of its market management powers under the Management Committee procedure, that the 2% reduction in the price of sugar will not affect the value of sugar stocks from 1988/89. The same applies to sugar intended for export but not yet exported.

6. Fresh fruit and vegetables

The Commission will carry out a study of varietal structure and conversion before the Council adopts a decision on premiums for the grubbing up of apple trees.

The Commission will propose including in the aid scheme for the processing of citrus fruit into juice, in principle for 1989/90, a mechanism for improving the evaluation of price fluctuations for such products imported into the Community.

Before the end of 1990/91 the Commission will consider and, where necessary, propose a revision of the threshold for apples for 1991/92 in the light of market developments.

7. Cotton

The Commission will examine the situation of small cotton producers and present, before 1 August 1989, a report together with suitable proposals for 1989/90.

8. Tobacco

The Commission intends revising the maximum guaranteed quantities for 1990/91 if changes take place in supply and demand or in prices.

9. Milk and milk products

The Commission will make appropriate proposals for the reduction in the co-responsibility levy as part of the proposals for agricultural prices and related measures from the 1990/91 marketing year.

The Commission will propose prolonging for 1989/90 the possibility of granting national aid for the consumption of butter (maximum ECU 50/100 kg).

In view of particular market situations and the problems affecting certain categories of producers, the Commission will carry out a study of the operation of the quota system and draw up, where necessary, appropriate proposals before 31 July 1989 to prevent distortions on the market and discrimination between producers.

The Council and the Commission state that account will be taken of current Community legislation and of the need to ensure the development of production when the reference quantity for Portugal is fixed in 1990.

10. Wine

The Commission intends examining, and where necessary making suitable proposals in the light of the socio-structural policy for the wine sector, the question of the transfer between growers of the right to replant vines producing table wine.

11. Hops

The Commission will propose an amendment to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2997/87 to extend its scope as regards areas liable to be included and limitations on surface areas and to extend the time limits.
