with request for topical and urgent debate pursuant to Rule 48 of the Rules of Procedure

on the need to give political momentum to the accession negotiations with Spain and Portugal

## The European Parliament,

- A. recalling its resolution of 17 November 1982 on the enlargement of the EEC to include Spain and Portugal,
- B. regretting that the pace of the accession negotiations with these two countries has not been sufficiently rapid to enable a precise date in the near future to be fixed for their entry into the EEC,
- C. whereas the presence of these two democratic countries will strengthen Europe's identity and increase the Community's capacity to defend its interests in the world,
- D. convinced that the difficulties standing in the way of a rapid conclusion of the negotiations are due as much to the EEC's inability to overcome a number of internal deadlocks as to the economic situation or specific characteristics of the two applicant countries,
- Calls on the forthcoming European Council meeting in Stuttgart to give fresh political momentum to the accession negotiations currently taking place;
- 2. Calls on the European Council to take at the same meeting the decisions concerning the regulation of Mediterranean agricultural products and own resources which are necessary to guarantee the financing of the common policies, so that these two problems, once resolved, may no longer serve as a pretext for slowing down the negotiations in progress;
- Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the European Council, the Council and the Commission.
