DECISION No. 24/55, June 14, 1955, amending Decision No. 14/55, of March 26, 1955, establishing financial arrangements to ensure a regular flow of scrap to the Common Market

THE HIGH AUTHORITY,

HAVING regard to Article 53, paragraph 1 (b) of the Treaty ;

HAVING regard to Article 65, paragraph 2 and to Article 80 of the Treaty;

Having regard to Decision No. 14/55, of March 26, 1955, establishing financial arrangements to ensure a regular flow of scrap to the Common Market (*Official Gazette of the Community, March* 30, 1955, p. 134);

WHEREAS it has proved impossible to lay down in a decision by June 15, 1955, the steps whereby measures in regard to the saving of scrap by an increased use of pig-iron are to be put into effect, as was required under Article 10 of Decision No. 14/55;

with the unanimous agreement of the Council of Ministers,

DECIDES :

Single Article

Article 10 of Decision No. 14/55 is hereby superseded by the following provision:

"The steps whereby the measures provided for in this decision in regard to the saving of scrap by an increased use of pig-iron are to be put into effect will be laid down in a decision to be taken not later than July 15, 1955, in conformity with Article 53, paragraph 1 (b) of the Treaty".

This decision was deliberated and adopted by the High Authority at its session on June 14, 1955.

1955, establishing financial arrangements to ensure a regular flow of scrap to the Common Market.

The Council, at its twenty-fifth session on June 8, 1955, gave its unanimous agreement, as recorded in the Minutes of its deliberations.

WHEREAS the Budget Estimates of the Community for the financial year 1955-56 were fixed on May 9, 1955, by the Committee set up under Article 78, paragraph 3 of the Treaty;

Article 1

The levies provided for in Articles 49 and 50 of the Treaty shall be collected in accordance with the conditions stated in the texts and decisions in force up to the expiry of the financial year ending June 30, 1956.

Article 2

This decision shall come into force within the Community on July 1, 1955.

Complaint by the "Società Industriale Lavorazione Ferro" (SILFER), San Vito al Tagliamento, dated March 4, 1955 (Case No. 4/55)

On March 4, 1955, a complaint was lodged before the Court of Justice against the High Authority of the European Coal and Steel Community (to which document a supplement was appended on June 13, 1955) by the Società Industriale Lavorazione Ferro ("Silfer"), San Vito al Tagliamento, represented by Dr. Mainardis Aldo fu Pietro.

The complainants contest the High Authority's claim to impose on them the levies provided for in Articles 49 and 50 of the Treaty and Decisions Nos. 2/52 and 3/52, of December 23, 1952, and by virtue of Article 79, paragraphs 1 and 2, and Articles 65 and 66.
