## The European Parliament,

- having regard to the substantial level of production of oils, fats and proteins within the European Community,
- alarmed at the high levels of uncontrolled imports of these or similar products from third countries,
- concerned at the contribution of these imports to Community surpluses, directly or indirectly, resulting in excessive expenditure,
- 1. Calls on the Commission to put forward proposals, as soon as possible, for a global EEC policy on oils, fats and proteins;
- Requests, in the interim, that negotiations be opened with third countries with a view to controlling the flow of imports of oils, fats and proteins into the Community;
- 3. Considers that the early elimination of imports of butter from New Zealand is essential;
- 4. Calls for the taxation of imported vegetable oils, which are a source of unfair competition for EEC oils and fats;
- 5. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and Commission.
