on Parliamentary Delegations

The European Parliament,

- acknowledging the important role played by Parliamentary Delegations in promoting the influence of the Community, in trade, political and development matters throughout the free world,
- mindful of the responsibility of Members of the European Parliament to the European taxpayer in the use of public funds,
- 1. instructs the Bureau immediately to review and make recommendations on:
 - a) The drastic reduction in the size of the delegations, so that each has the minimum representation of political groups and nationalities.
 - b) Reduction in the size of support staff on Delegations, particularly administrative services.
 - c) The frequency of Delegations so that each will travel only once every two years.
- 2. Instructs the Bureau to withold approval for any further Delegations until a full review has been completed of their cost effectiveness.
- 3. Instructs the Bureau that no further Delegations must be arranged without prior Parliamentary approval.
