SECTION I - PARLIAMENT

(A) Expenditure

Increase appropriations by 500,000 u.a.

(B) Revenue

Increase revenue by 500,000 u.a.

JUSTIFICATION

The enlarged Bureau having noted that since July 1972, when the regulations currently in force came into effect, there have been considerable increases in travel and subsistence costs, it was considered appropriate to increase as follows the allowances granted to Members:

- daily allowance: to be raised from 2,500 FB to 3,000 FB;
- travel allowances:
 - (a) 12 FB instead of 11 FB per kilometre for the first 400 kilometres;
 - (b) 5 FB instead of 3 FB per kilometre for additional kilometres.
