SECTION I - PARLIAMENT

A. EXPENDITURE

Title 9 'Food aid and other expenditure'

Chapter 99 'Expenditure not specifically provided for'

Article 990 'Expenditure not specifically provided for'

Item 9901 'Provision for new premises at Luxembourg,

Strasbourg and Brussels - fitting out,

equipment, rent'

Increase appropriations by 240,000 u.a.

B. REVENUE

Increase revenue by 240,000 u.a.

JUSTIFICATION

As pointed out in the remarks on the draft budget for 1975, the appropriations for rent are no more than indicative, since it was impossible to provide definitive figures. On the basis of a weighting, which provides for a possible increase of 15%, the difference between the initial estimates amounts to BF 12 million or 240,000 u.a.

It is proposed that this sum be entered under Item 9901, given that the parliamentary bodies responsible have not yet taken a final decision on rent.

Increase these resources by 34,071 u.a.

Article 550: Increase these contributions by 205,131 u.a.

Article 560: Increase these contributions by 4,205 u.a.
