

The Financial Controller has approved this proposal, attesting that the appropriations are available at 2 May 1979.

REASONS

After the proposals presented by the Commission, in April 1978, the Council adopted two research programmes on 27 March 1979:

- (i) on the phasing-out of nuclear installations (Decision No 79/344/Euratom, OJ No L 83 of 3 April 1979);
- (ii) on light-water reactor safety (Decision No 79/345/Euratom, OJ No L 83 of 3 April 1979).

The limit of commitments which can be entered into and the maximum number of officials necessary for its implementation are fixed for a period of five years from 1 January 1979.

In accordance with these principles, the budget headings concerning the expenditure on the two programmes in question have been created in the 1979 Budget but the appropriations relating to them have been entered in Chapter 100, pending the adoption of the decisions by the Council.

The proposed transfers relate to the total sum of appropriations allocated.
