

PELLA, Giuseppe

- Born Valdengo, Vercelli, Italy, 18.4.1902
- Degrees in economics and commerce
- Specialized in monetary and management problems
- 1932-39 : Took part in all international wool conferences as representative of Italian wool interests
- June 1946 : elected member of Constituent Assembly for Turin, Vercelli and Novara (re-elected 1948 and 1953)
- October 1946 : Under-Secretary of State, Ministry of Finance
- June 1947 : Minister of Finance
- May 1948 : Minister at the Treasury and acting Minister for the Budget
- July 1951 : Minister for the Budget
- February 1952 : Reappointed Minister at the Treasury
- Vice-President of the Interministerial Committee for Reconstruction
- Governor of the International Monetary Fund
- Italian representative on the Council of Ministers of O.E.E.C.
- August 1953-January 1954 : Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Minister for the Budget
- May 1954 : Member of the Common Assembly
- November 1954 : President of the Common Assembly (re-elected November 1955)
- Member of the Christian-Democrat Group.
