PRESS RELEASE

The EEC Commission has appointed M. Alain Prate to the post of Director-General for the Internal Market vacated by M. Pierre Millet.

M. Prate, who is 37, graduated from the Ecole Nationale d'Administration in 1952 and entered French government service in the Inspection Générale des Finances the following year. From July 1956 he took part in the Rome Treaty negotiations and joined the Commission's staff as Secretary of the Monetary Committee in May 1958. M. Prate was appointed Director for Economic Structure and Development in the Directorate-General for Economic and Financial Affairs in November 1961.

Né en 1928 à Lille, M. Alain PRATE est ancien élève de l'E.N.A. Entré à l'Inspection générale des Finances en 1953, chargé de mission à la Direction des Relations économiques extérieures, membre de la Délégation française à la Conférence intergouvernementale pour le Marché commun et l'Euratom, secrétaire du Comité monétaire de la Communauté économique européenne, puis directeur à la Commission économique européenne, il était depuis mai 1965, directeur général du Marché intérieur de la C.E.E.
