# £43M TO UNITED KINGDOM UNDER REGIONAL FUND

(Fourth allocation of grants, 1981)

The European Commission has announced grants of £43.44m under the European Regional Development Fund for 171 projects in the United Kingdom. The money will be paid to the UK Government in step with national expenditure on the projects concerned. This brings Regional Fund grants in Britain to £764m since the Fund began operations in 1975. A list of the newly financed projects is attached.

The fourth round 1981 includes a second grant to the Liverpool Maritime Museum, an imaginative and successful scheme involving the redevelopment of part of the Merseyside docklands. Monthly attendance figures at the museum increased in 1981 by 45 per cent over 1980. Grants are also given to a large number of investments connected with the development of industrial estates, which lead to the creation of jobs. Also assisted in this round are airports at Newcastle, Newquay and Speke (Liverpool), which all have an important regional impact. For Newcastle airport the grants is £1.45m. The terminal buildings are to be extended to cope with an expected 60 per cent increase in passengers by 1990. The extension of the offices in Cardiff of the Automobile Association Insurance Services Ltd is also worth noting: 484 jobs will be created by the investment involved.

This allocation also includes finance for a feasibility study into construction of a barrage at the mouth of the River Tawe, Swansea.

About two-thirds of ERDF grants are towards infrastructure projects. This finance is passed on in full to the local and other public authorities concerned, thus reducing the amount they have to borrow to finance the investment in question. As far as industrial projects are concerned, the Community grants now announced represent a Fund contribution of up to half the cost of the assistance given to individual projects by the UK Government. The grants are not paid to the companies concerned in addition to assistance they receive from Government.
