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## LABOUR FORCE SURVEY <br> Principal results1995

For the first time, the coverage of the Community Labour Force Survey has been extended to fifteen countries, with the inclusion of the three new EU Member States Austria, Finland and Sweden. In spring 1995 the population of the Union was measured at 366 million people, taking into account only private households. At that date :

- 148 million had a job during the survey reference week, giving an employment rate of $49.3 \%$ for the whole EU, with the lowest rate in Spain at 37\% and the highest in Denmark at 60\%
$-16 \%$ of people with jobs said that they worked part-time, $81 \%$ of these part-time workers being women
$-14 \%$ of employees had a work-contract of limited duration ( $35 \%$ of employees in Spain)
- 18 million people had no job but were available for work and looking for work, giving an unemployment rate of $10.7 \%$ for the whole EU, reaching $17 \%$ in Finland and $22.7 \%$ in Spain
- $49 \%$ of unemployed persons had been looking for work for over a year, and the same proportion had not completed upper-secondary level education
$-20 \%$ of unemployed persons were looking for their first job (the figure for Italy being over 50\%).

## 64.5\% of jobs are in services

In 1995 the services sector provided 54\% of male employment and 79\% of female employment in the EU. Only in this sector was employment equally distributed between men (49\%) and women (51\%).

Agriculture, forestry and fishing account for only $5.3 \%$ of employment in the EU, although this proportion is still as high as $20 \%$ in Greece, $13 \%$ in Ireland and $12 \%$ in Portugal

## Part-time work on the increase

The proportion of part-time workers in the EU is rising, although there are noticeable differences here between the Member States. Part-time working remains unusual in the southern countries, where it accounts for less than $10 \%$ of jobs, but this figures reaches $37 \%$ in the Netherlands. In the EU as a whole, part-time work is largely a preserve of women ( $31 \%$ of total female employment) and young people (19\% of total youth employment). Two-thirds of the women working
part-time said they did so voluntarily, compared with only one-third of the men.

## 14\% of employees have a fixed-term contract

The proportion of employees with a work-contract of limited duration:

- is particularly significant among young people (34.9\% of young employees); often these contracts cover a training period;
- forms a larger proportion of female employment (14.7\%) than male (13.5\%);
- still accounts for less than $20 \%$ of total employment in every Member State except Spain (35\%), where, despite the introduction of restrictions on the use of such contracts in 1994, the proportion of employees with a limited-term contract increased by 4\% in 1995.

## Explanatory notes

The European Labour Force Survey was conducted in spring 1995 in the 15 Member States of the European Union in accordance with Council Regulation (EEC) No. 3711/91 of 16 December 1991. For Austria the published results are for the first quarter of 1995.

A detailed description of the sampling methods, the adjustment procedures, the definitions and the common Community coding currently used in the labour force survey is presented in the publication Labour Force Survey - Methods and definitions, 1992 series.

## Basic concepts and definitions

All these definitions apply to persons aged 15 years and over, living in private households. The concepts and definitions used in the survey follow the guidelines of the International Labour Organisation. Persons carrying out obligatory military service are not included.

The survey does not cover persons living in collective households such as hostels, halls of residence, medical care establishments, religious institutions, collective workers' accommodation, etc. About 4 million people are estimated to live in such institutions.

Persons in employment are those who during the reference week did any work for pay or profit for at least one hour, or were not working but had jobs from which they were temporarily absent. Family workers are also included.

Unemployed persons are those who, during the reference week :
(a) had no employment, and
(b) were available to start work within the next two weeks, and
(c) had actively sought employment at some time during the previous four weeks.

In addition, unemployed persons include those who had no employment and had already found a job to start later.

Duration of unemployment is defined as:
(a) the duration of search for a job, or
(b) the length of the period since the last job was held (if this period is shorter than the duration of search for a job).

The active population is defined as the sum of persons in employment and unemployed persons.

Inactive persons are those who are not classified as persons in employment nor as unemployed persons.

Employees are defined as persons who work for a public or private employer and who receive compensation in the form of wages, salaries, fees, gratuities, payment by results or payment in kind; non-conscript members of the armed forces are also included.

Activity rates represent the labour force as a percentage of the population aged 15 years and over and living in private households.

Employment rates represent persons in employment as a percentage of the population aged 15 years and over and living in private households.

Unemployment rates represent unemployed persons as a percentage of the active population.
