The Financial Controller has approved this proposal, attesting that the appropriations are available at 7 June 1979.

## REASONS

On 24 May 1979 the Council, having received the opinion of the European Parliament on 27 April 1979, decided to make a financial contribution towards the campaign against foot—and—mouth disease in South—East Europe. This action will help prevent the spread of this virus, notably by the creation of buffer zones in these areas.

The total estimated cost of this action is 700.000 EUA, 300.000 EUA of which must be paid in 1979.

The anticipated expenditure to cover this action is to be charged against Article 3103 (Community contribution towards the campaign against foot—and—mouth disease outside the Community). At present, however, there is only a token entry against this Article.

In order to meet the planned expenditure for 1979 of 0,3 m EUA a transfer for this amount has to be made to Item 3103.

It is proposed to make this transfer from Item 8360 - Premium for the non-marketing of milk and the conversion of dairy herds.

Since the rate of implementation of the measure in respect of the non-marketing of milk has been slower than initially anticipated, a significant proportion of 1979 requirement can be financed from the 66 m EUA in appropriations for commitment outstanding from 1978 and by the appropriation for payment of the same amount automatically carried forward from 1978.
