Pursuant to Article 21(4) of the Financial Regulation, the Financial Controller has approved this proposal, attesting that the appropriations are available at 24 January 1979.

REASONS

On 10 October 1978, the Council decided (OJ No L 291, 17 October 1978) to amend its Decision 74/642/Euratom of 17 December 1974 (OJ No L 349, 28 December 1974) adopting a research and training programme on plutonium recycling in light-water reactors (indirect nuclear projects).

The amendment extends this programme by one year. The appropriations relating thereto are entered in Chapter 100, Provisional appropriations, of the 1979 Budget: 260 000 EUA in appropriations for commitment and in appropriations for payment.

The appropriations entered for 1979 under the Budget heading concerned, Item 3355, are solely to cover certain commitments still to be settled at 31 December 1978 and commitments to be made against the appropriations for commitment outstanding from the financial year 1978.

So that a start can be made on the work covered by the decision to extend the programme, it is proposed to transfer the amount of 260 000 EUA in appropriations for commitment and for payment from Chapter 100, Provisional appropriations, to Chapter 33, Expenditure on research and investment, Item 3355, Plutonium recycling in light-water reactors.

This transfer makes it necessary to release for use the permanent posts of three staff members on the establishment plan (1 A4, 1 A5 and 1 B2).
