## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Article 17 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 1117/78 on the common organization of the market in dried fodder provides that the system of aid for dehydrated potatoes should terminate on 30 June 1979.

It has not been possible to implement on 1 July 1979 the proposal for a Council Regulation (EEC) on the common organization of the market in potatoes, providing in particular for support measures for the above-mentioned dehydrated potatoes.

In these circumstances, in order to preserve continuity in the system of aid for dehydrated potatoes, the object of this proposal for a Regulation is to continue for the 1979/80 marketing year the system of aid existing under Regulation (EEC) No 1117/78.

At the same time it is proposed to continue for the 1979/80 marketing year the amount of the aid, i.e. 11.546 ECU per tonne.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and  
in particular Articles 42 and 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament (1),

Having regard to the Opinion of the Economic and Social Committee (2),

Whereas the Commission has submitted a proposal for a Council Regulation (EEC)  
on the common organization of the market in potatoes (3), providing in  
particular for a system of aid for the dehydrated potatoes referred to in  
Article 1 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 1117/78<sup>(4)</sup>;  
whereas it was envisaged that

the proposal for a Regulation in question would enter into force on 1 July  
1979; whereas, however, the entry into force of that Regulation on the date  
envisaged has not taken place; whereas, in order not to jeopardize the  
continuity of the system of aid for dehydrated potatoes, the existing  
arrangements should be continued for the 1979/80 marketing year,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

In the last paragraph of Article 17 of Regulation (EEC) No 1117/78 the date '30 June 1979' is replaced by '30 June 1980'.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply with effect from 1 July 1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1117/78 of 22 May 1978 on the  
common organization of the market in dried fodder<sup>(1)</sup>, and in particular Article  
3(3), thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament<sup>(2)</sup>,

Having regard to the opinion of the Economic and Social Committee<sup>(3)</sup>,

Whereas Article 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 1117/78 stipulates that the level of the  
production aid for dried fodder must be such as to bring about an improvement  
in the Community's protein supplies,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

For the 1979/80 marketing year the flat-rate production aid provided for in Article  
3 of Regulation (EEC) No 1117/78 shall be 11.546 ECU per tonne for the products  
referred to in Article 1(a) of that Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the Offi-  
cial Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply with effect from 1 July 1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in  
each Member State.
