BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES ON MRS SIMONE VEIL

Born Nice, 13 July 1927.

Simone JACOB married to Mr Antoine VEIL, Inspector of Finance, Managing Director of Union des Transports Aériens.

Three children, born 1947, 1949 and 1954; four grandchildren (two granddaughters born 1972 and 1977 and two grandsons, born 1977 and 1979).

Secondary education at a lycée in Nice.

Deported to Auschwitz and Bergen-Belsen from March 1944 to May 1945.

Bachelor of Law and graduate of the Institute of Political Studies in Paris.

Appointed to the magistrature by professional examination in 1956.

Appointed titular attachée in the Ministry of Justice, February 1957.

Between 1957 and 1969 held several posts in the Ministry of Justice (Directorate of Prison Administration, then Directorate of Civil Affairs and of the State Seal).

July 1969, joined the Private Office of Mr PLEVEN, Lord Chancellor.

In March 1970, appointed by the President of the Republic Secretary of the High Council of the Magistrature (a consultative body chaired by the President of the Republic).

July 1972, member of the board of directors of the French Radio and Television Authority and member of the board of directors of the Fondation de France.

Appointed Minister of Health on 28 May 1974 and confirmed in office on 27 August 1976 and 30 March 1977 when she also assumed responsibility for social security.

Appointed Chairman of the Board for Information on nuclear power on 10 November 1977.

Appointed Minister of Health and Family on 5 April 1978.

Elected to the European Parliament on 10 June 1979.

Elected President of the European Parliament on 17 July 1979.
