Biographical Note

Dr. Antonio Armellini

Dr. Armellini was born on August 2, 1943, in Rome, Italy.

In March 1962 he was appointed Assistant Spokesman of the Commission of the European Communities.

He was graduated in law from the University of Rome in 1967. On a Fulbright Scholarship he studied political science at Stanford University in 1962-63 and taught there in the Department of French and Italian the following year.

His professional activities prior to joining the Communities have included a year in the Economic and Social Affairs Directorate of the Council of Europe, Strasbourg, France, and six months in the Directorate as EEC Officer in the Italian Foreign Service's Directorate for Economic Affairs. In October 1969, he was appointed Executive Assistant to Mr. Aldo Moro, who was then Foreign Minister.

Dr. Armellini has published a number of articles on European and African politics and economics.

Dr. Armellini is married and resides in Brussels, Belgium.
