Michel F. Bosco is in charge of international cooperation and other horizontal activities within the Unit for RTD in Electronic Commerce, Technologies for Business Processes, Multimedia Systems, and the Open Microprocessor Initiative. He is also the "Esprit" Coordinator for Euro-Mediterranean Cooperation.

He has been in charge of various international scientific cooperation programmes of the European Commission since 1991, after having been for two years a scientific officer with the Unit for Basic Research and Scientific Relation in Information Technologies. His achievements include the design and launching of several new cooperation schemes between European and third countries.

Formerly Michel F. Bosco has been a Visiting Professor at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst, USA, a Lecturer at the University of Aix-Marseille, France, and a research scientist and project manager with the CETE Méditerranée, France. His research interests ranged from software engineering to database and information systems.
