## PREFACE

For the first time since the *Bulletin of the European Communities* took over from the separate Bulletins that existed before the Merger Treaty of 1965 was implemented, we are publishing an *Index* covering the activities of all three European Communities.

As a result, this indispensable work of reference is now of even greater interest to all readers since the matters dealt with by the *Bulletin* and the information it provides every month on the life of the Community have taken on a new dimension. Since the changeover, the *Bulletin* outlines the activities of the three Communities (ECSC, EEC, Euratom). This fact alone makes it still more necessary to consult the annual *Index*. These new factors and the changes which have gradually been made in the organization and presentation of the *Bulletin* also explain why it has taken longer than usual to compile the 1968 index.

The headings in this new index refer to the main chapters of the *Bulletin*:
