Chairman and CEO of the Board of Olympic Airways 1977. Governor of the National Bank of Greece 1979-1981. President of the Union of Greek Banks 1979-1981. Governor for Greece of the World Bank 1981. Has been Chairman or Member of the Board of many industrial, banking and insurance corporations in Greece and abroad. Member of the Budget Committee and of the Economic and Monetary Committee in the European Parliament. Head of Greek Delegation to the European Parliament.
