DR. KLAUS D. EBERMANN

Dr. Klaus D. Ebermann has been a member of the Cabinet of Roy Jenkins, the President of the European Community Commission, since January 1977. In this position, he is a member of Mr. Jenkins's personal staff with special responsibility for energy, the Community's competition and transport policies, the North/South Dialogue and research and science.

Dr. Ebermann was born in Germany in 1945. He studied law, politics and economics at the Universities of Berlin, Nuremberg and Hamburg.

From 1969 to 1973, he worked at the Court of Justice in Hamburg and then as an attorney with international law firms in Hamburg, London and Paris.

In 1973, he joined the West German's Ministry for Economic Affairs and worked in its Department of Industry in Bonn.

In 1975, he moved to Brussels, Belgium to join the European Community Commission. He moved to his present position two years later.
