Claus-Dieter Elhermann is Director-General of the Legal Service for the European Commission in Brussels, Belgium. In this position, he is general counsel to the executive Commission of the ten-nation European Community.

Born in Germany in 1931, Dr. Elhermann studied law at the universities of Marburg/Lahn and Heidelberg. After receiving his doctorate in law from the University of Heidelberg, he spent two years at the University of Michigan Law School in the United States.

From 1959-61, Dr. Elhermann was Research Assistant to Dr. Kutscher, Judge at the Federal Constitutional Court in Karlsruhe in the Federal Republic of Germany.

In 1961, he joined the European Commission in Brussels as a Legal Adviser in its Legal Service. In 1973 he became Director and Deputy Financial Controller in the European Commission's Directorate-General for Financial Control. He moved to his present post in 1977.

Dr. Elhermann is a German citizen and is married with two children.
