Guy F. Erb, a Senior Fellow with the Overseas Development Council, was previously a technical assistance expert for the United Nations Development Programme, with experience in Central America and South East Asia. He is a former member of the Secretariat of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development and was also on the staff of the President's Special Representative for Trade Negotiations while with the U.S. Foreign Service in 1963-65. He is the author of many articles on problems of economic development and the work of international organizations. Mr. Erb's work at the ODC is concentrated on the impact on developing countries of United States policies on trade, monetary reform and U.S. private investment abroad. He was educated at the University of California at Berkeley, the University of Madrid and the London School of Economics.
