Born on Feb. 4, 1897, in Fürth, Bavaria.

Studied Economics and Sociology at the Handelshochschule (Commercial University College) in Nuremberg (Dipl. Kfm. = B.Com.) and at the University of Frankfurt-on-Main (graduated as Doctor of Political Science under Franz Oppenheimer).

1928	Assistant Scientific Officer and later Director of the Institut für Wirtschaftsbeobachtung (Institute for Economic Studies), Nuremberg
1942	Director of the Institut für Industrieforschung (Institute for Industrial Research)
Oct. 1945 to end of 1946	Minister of Economics, Bavaria.
1947	Appointed Associate Professor of the Political Science Faculty at the University of Munich. President of the Special Currency and Credit Board.
March 2, 1948	Director of the "Verwaltung für Wirtschaft" (Economics Administration).
Aug. 14, 1949	Member of the Bundestag (West German Federal Government) (CDU = Christian Democratic Party)
Sept. 20, 1949	Federal Minister of Economics.
April 6, 1950	Appointed Associate Professor of the Law and Political Science Faculty at the Rheinische Friedrich-Wilhelms-University in Bonn.
July 1952	German Governor of the World Bank.
Dec. 1952	Honorary Doctorate in Engineering (Dr. Ing.h.c.) from the Technical University College, Berlin.
Feb. 1954	Honorary Doctorate in Economics (Dr.oec.h.c.) from the Hochschule für Wirtschafts- und Sozialwissenschaften (University College for Economic and Social Sciences), Nuremberg.
