John Farnell is Director of the Division of Standardization and Certification; relations with Standardization Bodies; and Notification Procedures in the Directorate-General for Internal Market and Industrial Affairs of the E.C. Commission.

He graduated from Cambridge University in 1970 (MA Economics and History) and has a MSc degree in International Relations from the London School of Economics.

After starting his career in British Airways and then the Confederation of British Industry, he joined the E.C. Commission in 1975, where he has worked in a number of departments, first in External Relations, then Fisheries, and most recently in Internal Market and Industrial Affairs.

From 1983 until 1987 he was responsible for international questions in the area of technical barriers to trade, representing the Community in the GATT Committee on Technical Barriers to Trade and in bilateral negotiations on standards issues, particularly with Japan and the United States.
