DEAR MR. EAGLEBURGER,
AS YOU KNOW, SINCE 1972 MEMBERS OF THE UNITED
STATES CONGRESS AND THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT HAVE HELD REGULAR
MEETINGS TO DISCUSS MATTERS OF MUTUAL CONCERN TO THE UNITED STATES AN
D
THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY. THESE MEETINGS
TAKE PLACE NORMALLY TWICE A YEAR, ONCE IN EUROPE AND
ONCE IN THE US. THE MOST RECENT MEETING OF THE TWO DELEGATIONS,
THE 17TH IN THE SERIES, WAS HELD IN COPENHAGEN AND STRASBOURG
IN NOVEMBER 1980.

THE NEXT MEETING, TO BE HELD IN WASHINGTON, IS NOW
DUE TO TAKE PLACE FROM 18 TO 21 MAY 1981. IN THE PAST, A
REGULAR FEATURE OF OUR DELEGATION VISITS TO WASHINGTON HAS
BEEN A TWO HOUR BRIEFING IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT GIVEN
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND HIS COLLEAGUES ON CURRENT US
FOREIGN POLICY THINKING, PARTICULARLY AS IT CONCERNS EUROPE.
WE HAVE ALWAYS FOUND THESE BRIEFINGS TO BE EXTREMELY INTERESTING
AND THEY HAVE COME TO BE REGARDED AS A HIGHLY VALUABLE
COMPONENT OF OUR VISITS TO WASHINGTON.

NEEDLESS TO SAY, OUR DELEGATION IS LOOKING FORWARD
WITH PARTICULAR INTEREST TO ITS FORTHCOMING VISIT, THE FIRST
SINCE THE INAUGURATION OF PRESIDENT REAGAN AND THE
APPOINTMENT OF THE NEW ADMINISTRATION. WE ARE PARTICULARLY
