From 1928 to 1967, when he resigned, Mr. HAGUIWARA served in the Ministry for Foreign Affairs. He was successively Minister to France and Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to Switzerland, Canada and France.

He has frequently represented Japan at international conferences, in particular at the annual meetings of the Contracting Parties to the GATT.

In 1968 Mr. HAGUIWARA was adviser to the Foreign Ministry and, from 1968 to 1971, Commissioner-General for the Japanese government for the World Exposition at Osaka.

Mr. HAGUIWARA, who was born in 1906, is a graduate of the Faculty of Law at Tokyo University.
