Ministry of Foreign Affairs, The Hague.

Member of Netherlands delegation negotiating the Treaty  
establishing the European Coal and Steel Community.

Member of Netherlands delegation to the Interim Commission  
appointed upon the signing of the Treaty.

August 10, 1952: administrative post with High Authority.

November 1952: appointed head of Agreements and Concentrations  
Division.
