

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Jacques Fauré was born in 1933 at Paris (France). After scientific studies specialized in mechanical engineering, aeronautics and heat transfer he obtained the title of Ingenieur, then became Docteur-es-sciences-physiques at the University of Paris in 1960.

Recruited in 1962 by the European Atomic Energy Community as Scientific Officer at the Joint Research Center at Ispra (Italy) J. Fauré entered the services of the Commission of the European Communities in Brussels in 1969.

He is now, as Head of Division, responsible for the execution of the community programme for the elimination of technical barriers to trade in industrial products in various field such as metrology, mechanics, metallurgy.
