- 1953 Higher secondary school-leaving certificate at the Akademisches Gymnasium in Vienna
- 1957 Law degree at the University of Vienna
- 1961 Examination for appointment to judicial office(following post-graduate training)
- 1961 Appointed judge, assigned to the Department of General Criminal Matters at the Federal Ministry of Justice
- 1963-1966 Judge in press matters at the Criminal Court in Vienna
- 1966-1970 Press adviser to the Federal Ministry of Justice
- 1970-1973 Attached to the International Affairs Department of the Federal Ministry of Justice, participation in international treaty negotiations, and in the Council of Europe (in working committees); also represented the Federal Government before the European Commission of Human Rights
- 1973-1978 Released from service for Parliament, Parliamentary Club of the Austrian People's Party, adviser to the Judicial Committee and club Press Adviser
- 1978 Appointed Member of the Constitutional Court (also permanent reporting judge in this Court since 1979)
- 1995 Appointed Judge at the Court of Justice of the European Communities; from 1995 until 1998, President of the First Chamber of this Court.
