- Obtained a law degree in 1940 (grade excellent) from the University of Athens.
- In 1951 came first in the competition and entered the Council of State.
- Between 1953 and 1955 studied public law at the University of Paris.
- Is currently a Councillor of State.
- Speaks English, French and Italian.
- Has published numerous studies and articles in legal and philosophical journals.
- Has taken part in international scientific congresses and has represented Greece at international scientific committees.
- Opposed the dictatorship.
- Testified in defence of democratic citizens summoned before military courts. As a result was deprived of his passport and his promotion was delayed.
- As Judge-Advocate in the Council of State he maintained during the dictatorship that the deportations being carried out then were unconstitutional and illegal, as was the junta's conscription of students opposed to it.
- Was responsible for the first three decisions of the Council of State to be formulated in demotic.
