European Steel Experts to Visit United States

A group of European steel experts will arrive in the United States on March 19 to make a six-week on-the-spot study of American management methods.

Their visit is being organized jointly by the American Iron and Steel Institute and the High Authority of the European Coal and Steel Community.

The experts, ^{are particularly} ~~who will be six in number, will be~~ specially interested in the different structure of American management as compared with its European counterpart, and will study which elements would be suitable for incorporation into the European structure.

After arrival in New York the group will spend two days with the American Iron and Steel Institute, whose Foreign Relations Committee Chairman, Mr. William H. Johnston, is handling the organization of the trip from the American end. The group will then split into two, half going to United States Steel, and the others to Inland Steel, where they will spend four weeks.
