Luxembourg Meeting on Vocational Training

More than a hundred experts from the six countries of the European Coal and Steel Community, together with delegates from Great Britain and the International Labour Office (ILO), will gather in Luxembourg from March 12 to 14 to discuss vocational training in steel-rolling mills. They will be particularly concerned with the repercussions of technical advances on the training of staff.

The Conference, which is being organised by the High Authority of the Community, will be presided over by MM. Paul Finet and Enzo Giacchero, Members of the High Authority. Representatives of the three political groups of the Community's Common Assembly will also participate in the work, as well as Community trade union representatives.

The subject of the Conference has been chosen in the light of the new methods of staff selection and training made necessary by the installation of many new modern rolling mills in the Community countries since the end of World War II.
