WORKING POPULATION AND EMPLOYMENT IN AN ENLARGED COMMUNITY



On 1 January 1986 the Community will encompass more than 321 mio Europeans, almost twice as many as at the time of its creation in 1958. The population of the six founder member states which was 169 mio at the signing of the treaty of Rome stands at 198 mio today. However the population of the Community was swollen by the inclusion of 64 mio inhabitants from the United Kingdom, Ireland and Denmark in 1973 followed by 10 mio from Greece in 1981.


Finally the adhesion of Spain and

Portugal adds a further 48 mio new "European" citizens bringing the total population to a level more than a third greater than that of the United States.

The population of the United States grew significantly (+35%) between 1958 and 1984, rising from 175 mio to 237 mio whereas the population of the Community, had it existed since 1958 in its enlarged form (12 countries) would have grown by only 17% from a starting level of 275 mio.

Spain and Portugal together have a significantly younger population than the Community average, comprising 24% of persons less than 15 years old, compared to 19% in a Europe of ten. However within the present Community the proportion of persons under 15 years old varies substantially, from less than 16% in the F.R. of Germany to nearly 30% in Ireland.

The adhesion of the United Kingdom, Ireland and Denmark contributed to a rise in activity rates in the Community, whereas the entry of Greece and currently of Spain and Portugal have the effect of lowering these rates. In 1984, 44% of the population of the Community of ten was in employment or unemployed, compared with only 35% in Spain, but 45% in Portugal. The activity rate in the United States was 49%.

More detailed information and explanatory notes are published regularly in "Employment and Unemployment", EUROSTAT, yellow series. The 1986 edition will appear next March. The statistics are compiled by national statistical services. The unemployment data for the ten member states is taken from the Community Labour force survey and for Spain and Portugal from similar national surveys. O.E.C.D. data has been used for comparisons with the USA.

These differences are even more acute in the case of female activity rates : 33% in the Community of ten, 21% in Spain, 36% in Portugal and 41% in the United States.

The activity rate of women in Portugal is inferior only to that of Denmark (49%) and the United Kingdom (37%). The lowest rate in the Community of 10 is that of Ireland (22%).

Total employment by sex and by sector of activity

In the enlarged Community the proportion of women varies widely from one sector of activity to another. In general there are fewer women in agriculture (35% of agricultural employment) and especially in industry (23%) but in the service sector they represent 45% of total employment.

Proportionately, there are fewer women in employment in industry than in the whole economy in all twelve countries without exception. The same cannot however be said for agriculture.




Female employment represents 44% of the total in agriculture in Greece and 49% in the F.R. of Germany and in Portugal, whereas as a proportion of total employment in these countries women represent 33%, 39% and 40% respectively. In Italy the situation in agriculture reflects that in the whole economy i.e. one woman in employment for every two men.

In services only Greece has a lower proportion of women in employment in this sector than in the economy as a whole.

The picture in the United States is one of extremes. Women employed in agriculture comprise only one fifth of the total but in the services sector women outnumber men. The proportion of women in total employment is 43%.

Structure of employment by sector of activity


In 1984, employees represented an average of 82,4% of total employment in the Community of ten. When Spain and Portugal are included this figure falls slightly to 80,8% due to a lower proportion of employees in both Spain and Portugal at just under 70%, similar to that in Italy but superior to the level in Greece where it is estimated to be only 51,6%.

These differences do not apply equally to all sectors of activity. In agriculture where the average for the Community of ten is 24,7%, employees represent 27,9% of total employment in this sector in Spain and 21,2% in Portugal, whilst in Greece the figure is only 3,9%. It should also be noted that employees represent 54,7% of employment in agriculture in the United Kingdom.


In industry, the proportion of employees in Portugal (90%) is similar to the Community average, whilst in Spain (84,8%) the figure is more in line with that of Italy.

Employees represent 73,4% of employment in services in Spain and 82,8% in Portugal compared with 85,1% in the Community of ten. In both Italy and Greece this figure is only 70%.


All sectors 1984




Agriculture
