Monsieur Otto RIESE, Judge of the Court.

- 27 October 1894 born at Frankfurt-am-Main, Germany.
- Studied law at the University of Leipzig, Frankfurt-am-Main, and Lausanne.
- 1921 Doctor of Laws.
- 1923 Assessor at the Regional Court (Landgericht) of Frankfurt-am-Main.
- 1925-1927 Served in the Ministry of Justice.
- 1928 Studied English law in London. Oberregierungsrat, then Ministerial Counsellor at the Ministry of Justice.
- At the University of Lausanne: 1932, Chargé de Cours; 1935, Professor extraordinaire; 1949, Professeur ordinaire; 1950, Dean of the Faculty of Law.
- 1951 Honorary Professor at the University of Lausanne.
- President of one of the Chambers of the Bundesgerichtshof at Karlsruhe.
- Delegate at numerous international conferences, particularly those concerned with maritime law and the unification of the laws of the air.
- Since 1926 Member of the International Technical Committee of Legal Experts on the Law of the Air (CITEJA).
- Since 1952 Member of the International Committee for the unification of the law of sale.
- *Judge at Court of Justice starting 4 Dec. 1952*
- 1953 and 1956 President of one of the Chambers of the Court of Justice.
- 1958 Judge of the Court of Justice of the European Communities.
